In response to the rapid spread of the COVID-19 virus the US Congress passed the Families First Corona Response Act (FFCRA) in March 2020. The Act was intended to support employees and their families during the closing of business, daycares, and schools. In the six months since the FFCRA became law the Department of Labor (DOL) has issued several interpretive documents and responses to frequently asked questions (FAQs). In the first part of this two-part webinar the Kansas Bankers Association (KBA) will examine the FFCRA as it is interpreted today, address some previous misinterpretations of the act, and identify resources member banks can utilize to prepare for the upcoming school year.

The second part of the webinar will examine the most common questions the KBA has received from member banks regarding the FFCRA including, but not limited to, the interaction between the FFCRA and the Family Medical Leave Act, when an employee travels to a hotspot, what to do if a bank employee or customer tests positive for COVID-19, who must the bank notify in the event an employee tests positive for COVID-19, and what happens when the FFCRA leave is exhausted.
