Who Should Attend:

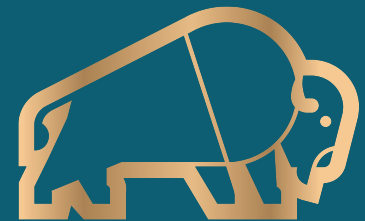
