Additionally, this position is responsible for staff development of business technology and architectural staff to ensure ongoing skill development.

What qualifications are needed?

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent work experience.
- Senior level of competency with at least ten years of similar or related professional experience.
- Minimum of ten years of continuous IT and business work experience, including experience managing multiple, medium to large, cross-functional teams or projects, and influencing senior level management and key stakeholders.
- Combination of eight plus years of hands-on development experience in a full-life cycle software development organization.
- Proven experience in overseeing the direction, development and implementation of software solutions.
- Advanced understanding of database design, programming concepts, and web development is required.
- Ability to communicate ideas in both technical and user-friendly language.
- Two or more years' of experience with Agile development methodologies is preferred. Must be able to work and travel independently and use general office equipment.
