The Scrum Master responsibilities include facilitating and championing the agile software development process by coaching and mentoring teams, identifying and eliminating impediments, and promoting the use of standards and best practices. This position ensures smooth operation of agile processes and activities, and is responsible for leading daily stand-ups, backlog prioritization meetings, and retrospectives. This includes activities such as planning, estimating, prioritizing, execution, implementation and post implementation support for internal and third-party developed applications that may cross multiple business divisions. Works collaboratively with the IT Business Technology Solutions Managers and their teams to plan, design and deliver solutions in compliance with established Solutions Delivery Life Cycle (SDLC) requirements.

What qualifications are needed?

- Bachelor's degree and/or equivalent work experience. Scrum certification is required.
- Intermediate level of competency with three to five years of similar or related professional experience, including hands-on experience managing complex projects in both Agile and traditional management methodologies, as well as exposure to risk management.
- Deep knowledge of agile practices, frameworks, and techniques.
- Excellent people and project management skills.
- Minimum of three years of banking and financial systems experience is preferred. (Experience may be in operational or information technology aspects of the financial sector.)
- Experience with Microsoft technologies is required.
- Experience with Agile Project Management tools, such as Jira/Greenhopper, Rally, VersionOne, Azure DevOps or equivalent is required.
- Experience managing, mentoring and coaching small teams.
- Strong leadership, customer service and facilitation skills.
- Ability to assign, coordinate and prioritize tasks with strong multi-tasking skills.
- General understanding of programming concepts and web development is required.
- Proven analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Resourcefulness and creativity when researching new products and techniques.
- Must be able to work and travel independently and use general office equipment.
- Must be goal-oriented and have a strong sense of team solidarity.
