Harbor House at Catholic Charities is more than a safe shelter for survivors of severe violence. Harbor House uses outreach advocacy services to guide survivors of abuse through the judicial, medical and DCF systems.

Harbor House provides a variety of services each year to hundreds trying to leave abusive relationships but who never step foot in the shelter. All services are provided with the goal of breaking the cycle of violence against women and their children.

HARBOR HOUSE OFFERS THESE SERVICES FREE OF CHARGE:

- 24-hour hotline (316-263-6000).
- Individualized safety planning.
- Assistance with district court services, including advocacy, protection orders and more.
- Counseling, support groups and educational courses (i.e. healthy relationships, parenting and budgeting).
- Case management (employment and job training, housing and support in court).
- Economic advocacy.
- Referrals to community resources.

FOR THOSE STAYING IN THEIR EMERGENCY SHELTER FOR SURVIVORS AND THEIR MINOR CHILDREN, HARBOR HOUSE ALSO OFFERS:

- Peace of mind in a secured facility in an undisclosed location.
- Privacy with 12 furnished resident units, each with a private bathroom.
- Three meals each day in a cafeteria.
- Transportation assistance.
- Personal hygiene and room cleaning supplies.
- Health assessments and referrals for medical needs.
- Special attention to children's schooling, physical and mental health, and developmental needs.
- Children's programs, as well as indoor and outdoor areas.
- An assigned case manager who will assist with establishing a housing plan, obtaining employment, applying for housing support services, arranging child-care and making referrals to other service providers in the community.
- Referrals for drug, alcohol and mental health counseling.
