PURPOSE

The Kansas Bankers Association Internship Connection Program partners with Kansas colleges and universities to provide college students with dynamic internships in the banking industry across the state.

LEARNING & NETWORKING OPPORTUNITIES

Students interning at a Kansas bank will gain hands-on experience learning how a bank operates and potentially specialize in a specific area of banking. Potential areas could include:

Agricultural lending, Bank Administration, Commercial banking, Human Resources, Information Technology, Operations, Personal Banking, Public Relations and Marketing.

Students can also meet bankers in their area of interest through networking at a KBA conference. A complimentary registration will be provided for one conference listed below. A student's host bank is encouraged to cover travel and hotel expenses. Visit the KBA website for conference details.

APPLICATION & CONNECTION PROCESS

Students can apply to the program on the KBA website; applications open on September 13th and close on March 31st, 2025. Students are connected with banks based on two factors: 1) where the student has housing and 2) what institutions they preference within their housing area. Students can request that their application materials be sent to an institution that provides housing.

Once a student's application is received, KBA staff sends it and the student's resume to their preferred institutions. Banks and trust companies have two weeks to review and decide whether to proceed with an interview. If an institution does not communicate within two weeks of receiving the student's materials, staff will proceed with connecting the student with their other preferences.

Students and banks will determine wages, working time per week, and start/end dates. All internships will be paid a minimum of \$15 per hour. KBA is not involved in the interview process past making a connection between a student and a bank.
