APPLICATION & CONNECTION PROCESS

Students can apply for internships on the KBA website between September 14th, 2026, and April 30th, 2027.

Based on the locations where a student has available housing, KBA staff provide the student with contact information for participating banks and trust companies in those counties. Housing may include a student's hometown, college community, or the community of a friend or family member.

Students are responsible for contacting participating institutions, expressing interest in internship opportunities, and inquiring about available positions.

KBA facilitates connections between students and participating institutions. Internship interviews, hiring decisions, onboarding, compensation, and other employment arrangements are handled directly between the student and the institution.
